

How to relocate telecommunications fiber optic cables

Relocating a fiber optic cable requires careful planning, proper handling to avoid bends or damage, and coordination with your service provider to maintain connectivity.

Planning the Move

Before relocating, assess the new location for the fiber cable and modem or ONT (Optical Network Terminal). Ensure the new spot has a dedicated power source, is near networking hardware, and avoids areas with heat, moisture, or high foot traffic . Map the pathway carefully, prioritizing short, straight routes through basements, attics, or existing conduits to minimize stress on the fiber .

Handling the Fiber Cable

Fiber optic cables are fragile and sensitive to bending. Maintain a minimum bend radius of at least 15 times the cable diameter to prevent signal loss or breakage . Avoid sharp angles, stretching, or crushing the cable. Use protective caps on fiber ends during disconnection to prevent contamination or damage . Soft Velcro ties or flexible low-voltage conduit can secure the cable without compromising its integrity .
