

How to use a fiber optic connector to connect to a router

To connect a fiber optic cable to a router, you typically use an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert the fiber signal to Ethernet, which then connects to your router's WAN port.

Step 1: Gather Necessary Equipment

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Provided by your ISP, it converts optical signals into electrical signals your router can use .
- Fiber optic cable: Usually single-mode with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- Router: Ensure it supports fiber input or has a WAN port for Ethernet connection .
- Ethernet cable: Cat6a or higher is recommended to maintain high speeds .

Step 2: Install the ONT

- Locate the fiber wall outlet where your ISP's fiber line enters your home .
- Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's optical port. Remove protective caps and handle the connector by its housing to avoid damage .
- Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize, which may take a few minutes .

Step 3: Connect the ONT to Your Router

- Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to your router's WAN/Internet port .
- Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection .
