

How to use the fiber optic connector in a switch

To connect a fiber optic cable to a switch, insert a compatible SFP/SFP+ module into the switch port, then attach the fiber cable with matching LC connectors, ensuring proper send/receive orientation and clean connections.

Step-by-Step Guide

1. Verify Compatibility Ensure your switch has available SFP or SFP+ ports and that the module matches the network speed and fiber type (single-mode for long distances, multi-mode for short distances) you plan to use . 2. Prepare the SFP/SFP+ Module

- Check the module for dust caps and remove them carefully.
- Avoid touching the optical interface to prevent contamination.
- Confirm the module type matches the fiber cable (e.g., duplex LC connectors for most modern SFPs), . 3. Insert the SFP Module into the Switch
- Align the module with the port and gently slide it in until it clicks or locks.
- Most SFP modules are hot-swappable, so you can insert them without powering down the switch .
- Ensure the module is fully seated and secure. 4. Connect the Fiber Optic Cable
- Use a duplex fiber cable with LC connectors (or the connector type supported by your module).
- Connect the transmit (TX) port of the module to the receive (RX) port of the other device, and vice versa, to maintain proper signal flow
