

How to wire the grounding flat iron of the distribution box

To connect a flat iron grounding wire to a distribution box, attach it securely to the PE (grounding) bar using a copper wire and fasteners, ensuring a firm, reliable connection.

Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Locate the Grounding Bar (PE Bar) Open the distribution box and identify the grounding bar, often marked with "PE" or a grounding symbol. This is the designated point for all grounding connections in the box .
2. Prepare the Grounding Wire Use a yellow-green insulated copper wire with a cross-sectional area meeting the specifications for your system. Strip the insulation for a sufficient length to expose the copper conductor for connection .
3. Connect the Ground Wire Attach the flat iron grounding wire to the PE bar using screws, nuts, and washers. Ensure the connection is tight and secure to maintain electrical continuity . If connecting multiple components, you can use additional copper wires to link them to the PE bar .
4. Ground Electrical Components If there are other devices or components inside the distribution box that require grounding, connect them to the PE bar using copper wires. This ensures all equipment shares a common, safe ground .
5. Verify the Connection After installation, test the grounding resistance using a grounding resistance tester. The resistance should not exceed 4 ohms. If it does, adjust the grounding electrodes or connections until the requirement is met .
6. Safety and Maintenance Ensure all connections are clearly marked and free from looseness. Regularly inspect the grounding system to maintain safety and compliance with ele...
