- Safety First
 - Ensure the PV system is completely de-energized before installation.
 - Wear insulated gloves, safety glasses, and use tools rated for DC voltage.
 - Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC) and obtain necessary permits .
- Select the Location
 - Install in a well-ventilated area, away from direct sunlight, flammable materials, and extreme weather.
 - Ensure the enclosure meets IP65 or higher for outdoor protection.
 - Position the box for easy access during maintenance and testing
