

Installation height of distribution box in power distribution room



Article Overview

The recommended installation height for an electrical distribution box is typically between 1.4 meters (4.5 feet) and 1.8 meters (6 feet) from the floor, depending on accessibility, safety, and applicable standards.

Recommended Heights

- **Residential Settings:** Distribution boxes should generally be mounted between 1.4 m and 1.8 m from the floor to ensure easy access without bending or stretching excessively, while keeping the box out of reach of children . For elderly or disabled individuals, a height around 1.3 m may be more suitable .
- **Industrial Settings:** The height may vary depending on equipment layout and space constraints, but the box should remain easily accessible and comply with IP/NEMA protection requirements . Wall-mounted boxes should be installed in dry, well-ventilated areas, while floor-mounted boxes should have the back panel at least 0.5 m above the ground to prevent moisture damage .

Safety and Accessibility Considerations

- Keep the box away from damp or contaminated areas to reduce the risk of electric shock .
- Ensure adequate working space around the box for maintenance and inspection, as required by BS 7671 and IEC 61439 .
- Avoid installing the box in bathrooms, closets, or behind obstructions such as pipe...
