

Installation of Explosion-proof Lighting Distribution Box

Installation of an explosion-proof lighting distribution box requires strict adherence to safety standards, proper grounding, correct wiring, and secure mounting to ensure safe operation in hazardous environments.

Preparation and Safety Measures

Before installation, ensure the power supply is completely turned off to prevent electrical hazards . Only use cables, connectors, and components rated for explosion-proof applications (EX or ATEX certified) and resistant to flame, impact, and mechanical damage . The installation should be performed by a qualified professional familiar with hazardous area electrical codes . Avoid opening the box cover while the power is on, and protect all explosion-proof joint surfaces from scratches during installation or maintenance .

Mounting Methods

Explosion-proof lighting distribution boxes can be installed using one of the following methods :

- Wall-mounted surface installation – secure the box directly to a wall using appropriate fasteners. Ensure the box is level and the perpendicularity deviation does not exceed 3 mm .
- Embedded installation – the box is recessed into a wall or structure, with edges sealed and coated with anti-corrosion paint to prevent moisture ingress
