

Installation of dry cable trays on construction site

Importance of Dry Storage

Cable trays serve to support, protect, and dissipate heat from electrical cables. Dry storage prevents these issues and maintains the structural integrity of the trays before installation .

Best Practices for Storage

- **Horizontal Placement:** Store trays horizontally on a flat surface to avoid bending or warping.
- **Timber Supports:** Place timber supports at intervals of approximately one meter to evenly distribute weight and prevent sagging .
- **Covering:** Protect trays from rain, moisture, and direct sunlight using tarpaulins or other protective covers. This is particularly important for galvanized or painted steel trays to maintain their corrosion resistance .
- **Inspection:** Check all trays for damages, scratches, or coating defects before installation. Any compromised trays should be removed from the site .
