Public Safety

Fiber optic cables transmit data using infrared light through a glass or plastic core, which is fully contained within the cable and does not emit radiation into the surrounding environment, making them inherently safer than wireless technologies like 5G in terms of electromagnetic exposure . The cables carry no electrical current, so there is no risk of electrocution, and they do not generate heat, reducing fire hazards . Once installed and intact, fiber optic cables present minimal chemical or physical risk to the general public .

Physical Hazards

The main safety concerns arise during installation, maintenance, or repair. The glass core can produce microscopic shards if cut or broken, which can puncture the skin, cause irritation, or lead to infection . These shards are difficult to see and can be accidentally inhaled or ingested, potentially causing internal injuries. Technicians must follow strict safety protocols, including using adhesive tape or specialized containers to dispose of fragments and avoiding eating or drinking near exposed fibers .
