

Is the distribution box a secondary distribution box



Overview

A distribution box acts as the load center and main distributor of electrical power within a building. Also called a distribution board, panel board, breaker panel, or electric panel, it is the central hub in an electrical system that divides incoming power into various circuits. The terms primary, secondary, and tertiary distribution boxes are relative. Let's make an example for clarity: A newly constructed residential area introduces a 10kV power line to a substation. From the transformer's low-voltage side (0.4kV), the outgoing line is led to the distribution cabinet (primary distribution cabinet), then the outgoing line is led to the distribution box (secondary distribution box) in each building, and finally the outgoing line is led to the distribution cabinet. Class I distribution box: the construction power distribution cabinet is used for construction power on the construction site. A feeder usually begins with a feeder breaker at the distribution substation. Many feeders leave substation in concrete ducts and are routed to a nearby pole.
