A fiber splitter in a fiber distribution box divides a single optical signal into multiple outputs, enabling efficient distribution to multiple end users in FTTx networks.

Function and Purpose

A fiber distribution box (FDB) serves as a termination and management point for feeder cables connecting to drop cables in FTTx or FTTH networks . Within this box, a fiber splitter is installed to divide the incoming optical signal from the feeder cable into multiple outputs, allowing a single fiber to serve multiple subscribers. This is essential in passive optical networks (PON), where split ratios like 1:16, 1:32, or 1:64 are common .

- **Compact Design:** Modern FDBs with splitters are compact and space-saving, suitable for wall-mounted, pole-mounted, or outdoor installations .

- **Scalability:** Splitter-equipped FDBs allow network expansion without major infrastructure changes, supporting future growth in subscriber numbers
