Submarine Cables

North Asia is connected to the global internet through several submarine fiber optic cables, such as the Fibre-optic Link Around the Globe (FLAG), which links Japan, India, and Europe via undersea routes . FLAG is just one of many international cables; other submarine systems also connect Japan, South Korea, China, and Russia to global networks, providing redundancy and high-capacity data transmission.

Terrestrial and Cross-Border Networks

Most countries in Asia have developed their own domestic fiber optic backbones, and many cross-border terrestrial fiber networks exist between neighboring countries . These networks are interconnected through bilateral agreements, allowing data to flow efficiently across borders. While operational challenges exist, such as interoperability and cost settlement, these terrestrial networks significantly enhance regional connectivity and reduce reliance on a single cable.
