

Leaky Cable Optical Cable

A leaky optical cable occurs when light escapes from the fiber due to bends, physical damage, or environmental factors, leading to signal loss and degraded network performance.

Causes of Optical Cable Leakage

Microbends and Macrobends: Small distortions in the fiber core (microbends) or large bends beyond the minimum radius (macrobends) cause light to escape, reducing signal strength and increasing attenuation. Adhering to the manufacturer's bend-radius guidelines (typically $\geq 10 \times$ cable diameter for single-mode fibers) and using bend-insensitive fibers can prevent this issue . **Physical Damage:** Crushing, over-stretching, or rodent attacks can break or deform the fiber, allowing light to leak out. Outdoor or underground cables are particularly vulnerable to mechanical impacts and environmental stress . **Moisture Ingress:** Water entering loose-tube or slotted-core cables can corrode fibers and connectors, causing reflection loss and signal degradation. Proper sealing, IP67-rated cables, and waterproof connectors help prevent moisture-related leakage . **Connector and Splice Issues:** Dust, oil, scratches, or improper splicing at connectors can block or scatter light, creating localized signal loss. Regular cleaning with fiber cleaning kits and inspection under a microscope is essential .
