

Must vertical cable trays be installed with supports

Yes, vertical cable trays require supports to ensure structural integrity, prevent mechanical stress on cables, and comply with installation standards.

Support Requirements for Vertical Cable Trays

Vertical cable trays must be supported to safely carry the weight of the cables and withstand environmental or mechanical loads. Unlike horizontal trays, where cable weight may help keep cables in place, vertical runs rely entirely on supports to prevent sagging, bending, or undue stress on conductors. Supports also help maintain proper alignment and spacing, which is critical for heat dissipation and long-term cable performance.

Recommended Support Spacing

The spacing of supports depends on the tray type, load, and manufacturer specifications:

- Short-span trays: typically supported every 6 to 8 feet.
- Intermediate-span trays: supported every 10 to 12 feet.
- Long-span trays: supported every 14 to 20 feet, with 20 feet being common.
- Extra-long spans: may exceed 20 feet, but require careful planning and splice plate placement. For vertical transitions, cables should be fastened to the tray's transverse members to prevent movement and mechanical stress. Unsupported sp...
