

National Standard Tolerances for Galvanized Cable Trays



Article Overview

Galvanized cable trays must comply with NEMA VE 1 and IEC 61537 standards, which define material thickness, dimensional tolerances, and corrosion protection requirements.

Material and Coating Requirements

Galvanized cable trays are typically made from steel with either pre-galvanized (electro-galvanized) or hot-dip galvanized coatings. The zinc coating provides sacrificial protection, forming a protective patina that resists corrosion. The thickness of the zinc layer is a key factor in corrosion resistance and varies depending on the galvanization process used, with hot-dip galvanization generally providing a thicker, more durable coating than electro-galvanization (ABB Technical Guide) .

Dimensional Tolerances

Standards such as NEMA VE 1 specify tolerances for metal cable trays, including ladder, ventilated, solid-bottom, and channel types. These tolerances cover:

- Tray width and height: Typically ± 3 mm for standard widths and heights, depending on manufacturer specifications and tray type.
- Rung spacing: Usually ± 2 mm to ensure proper cable support and load distribution.
- Bend angles and straightness: Deviations are limited to maintain structural integrity and proper alignment during installation....
