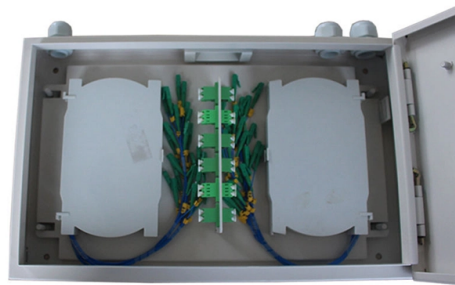


No pigtail just connect the connector



Overview

Normally you solder a male header to the board, and if you aren't plugging them directly into another board, you connect them with either ribbon cables or jumpers that have individual sockets on the end. These jumpers are available in m-m, f-f, and m-f configurations. Make no mistake, installing arc fault breaker without pigtail defeats the purpose of an AFCI, as you need the neutral pigtail for it to function fully. Your best bet is an AFCI plug-on breaker, which requires a specific plug-on panel that fits that newer breaker type. I'll explain what happens if.
