

Outgoing wires from the water and electricity distribution box

Outgoing wires from a distribution box carry electricity from protective devices to subcircuits, connecting lighting, power outlets, and appliances while ensuring safety through MCBs, RCCBs, and proper earthing.

Overview of Distribution Box Wiring

A distribution box (DB), also called a distribution board or consumer unit, is the central hub where incoming electrical power is split into multiple subcircuits for a building or home . The main supply enters the DB through a main isolator or double-pole MCB, which allows manual disconnection of the entire system . From there, the power is routed through protective devices such as RCCBs (Residual Current Circuit Breakers) for leakage protection and MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers) for overcurrent protection .

Outgoing Wires

The outgoing wires from the DB are the lines that carry electricity from the MCBs or RCCBs to the various subcircuits and final circuits in the building:

- **Phase (Live) Wires:** These wires carry the current from the MCBs to lighting points, power outlets, fans, air conditioners, and other appliances . Each MCB typically protects one subcircuit.
- **Neutral Wires:** Connected to a neutral busbar, these wires complete the circuit ba...
