

Parallel cable trays climbing slope



Article Overview

When installing parallel cable trays on a slope, proper alignment, support spacing, and cable securing are essential to ensure mechanical stability and prevent cable slippage.

Alignment and Spacing

Parallel cable trays should be installed with consistent spacing to allow for maintenance access and to prevent interference between trays. The spacing depends on the tray width, cable type, and load, but a minimum clearance of 50–100 mm between trays is commonly recommended to facilitate cable installation and airflow . Ensure that the trays are aligned along the slope to maintain uniform support and avoid twisting or uneven loading.

Support and Load Considerations

Cable trays on slopes must be supported at intervals that account for the combined weight of the tray and cables, as well as environmental loads such as wind or ice . Standard support intervals for ladder or ventilated trays typically range from 1.5 to 3 meters, but this may need adjustment for steep slopes or heavy cable bundles. Supports can include wall brackets, ceiling hangers, or floor-mounted stands, and they should be designed to prevent tray deflection or sagging.

Cables in sloped trays must be restrained to prevent movement due to gravity, esp...
