Understanding PoE Switches

A PoE (Power over Ethernet) switch delivers both data and electrical power over a single Ethernet cable to devices such as IP cameras, VoIP phones, wireless access points, and IoT devices, eliminating the need for separate power adapters and simplifying installation . PoE switches come in different standards:

- PoE (IEEE 802.3af): Supplies up to 15.4W per port
 - PoE+ (IEEE 802.3at): Supplies up to 30W per port
 - PoE++ (IEEE 802.3bt): Supplies up to 60W or 100W per port
- Choosing the right standard depends on the power requirements of your devices, especially for high-demand equipment like PTZ cameras or Wi-Fi 6 access points .

Combining PoE Switches

When combining multiple PoE switches in a network:

- Match PoE Standards: Ensure all switches support the required PoE standard for your devices. For example, high-power devices may require PoE++ switches to avoid instability .
- Calculate Total Power Budget: Each switch has a maximum PoE budget. Add the power requirements of all connected devices and ensure the switch can supply sufficient power, accounting for cable losses (e.g., ~3.2W loss over 100m Cat6A ca...
