

Professional installation of cable trays in factory buildings



Article Overview

Proper cable tray installation in factories ensures organized wiring, safety, and long-term reliability while complying with electrical standards.

Planning and Design

Before installation, plan the cable tray route based on the factory layout, electrical load, and clearance requirements. Consider separation of high-power and low-power cables to prevent electromagnetic interference, and avoid areas with moving machinery or high heat sources . Review approved shop drawings to confirm tray lengths, locations, and routing paths . Proper planning reduces rework and ensures coordination with HVAC, piping, and structural elements .

Tray Selection and Sizing

Choose the appropriate tray type for the application:

- Ladder trays: Ideal for high-power cables, allow airflow, and prevent overheating.
- Perforated trays: Suitable for lighter loads and moderate protection.
- Solid-bottom trays: Best for sensitive data or control cables, providing dust and debris shielding . Calculate tray width and depth based on cable count, type, and spacing guidelines. Avoid overfilling; power cables should not exceed 40% of tray cross-section, and control cables 50% . Leave approximately 20% extra capacity for future expansion
