A distribution box protects electrical circuits through a robust enclosure, internal protective devices, and organized component layout to prevent overloads, short circuits, and accidental contact.

Enclosure and Material

The enclosure forms the outer shell of a distribution box, shielding internal components from mechanical damage, dust, moisture, and accidental contact. Enclosures are typically made of metal (stainless steel or galvanized steel) or plastic (PVC or polycarbonate). Metal enclosures offer high mechanical strength, fire resistance, and durability, making them suitable for industrial or outdoor environments, while plastic enclosures are lightweight, corrosion-resistant, and commonly used in residential settings. Enclosures often have an IP rating indicating protection against dust and water, ranging from basic (IP20) to high protection (IP69) depending on the application.

Internal Protective Components

Inside the distribution box, several components ensure safety and controlled power distribution:

- **Circuit Breakers and Fuses:** Automatically interrupt the flow of electricity during overloads or short circuits, preventing damage and fire hazards. Fuses melt under excessive current, while circuit breakers trip to stop current flow.
- **Busbars:** Solid copper or aluminum strips that distribute electricity from the main...
