For example, when a straight section of tray is cut to length and used in conjunction with a factory fitting — this installation would also. Cable tray may be used as the Equipment Grounding Conductor (EGC) in any installation where qualified persons will service the installed cable tray system. There is no restriction as to where the cable tray system is installed. The metal in cable trays may be used as the EGC as per the limitations.
