

# Requirements for cable tray support screws

## Article Overview

Cable tray installation screws must comply with IEC 61537 standards, be corrosion-resistant, and match the tray system's load and material specifications.

### Standards and Compliance

Screws used for cable tray installation should meet the IEC 61537:2006 standard for cable management systems, ensuring they are suitable for supporting and routing cables in low-voltage applications . For installations in the UK or Europe, compliance with BS EN 61537 is recommended . Using screws that meet these standards ensures structural integrity, safety, and compatibility with the cable tray system.

### Material and Corrosion Resistance

The screws must be made of corrosion-resistant materials, such as stainless steel or galvanized steel, to withstand indoor and outdoor environments . The choice of material should match the cable tray's material (e.g., steel, aluminum) to prevent galvanic corrosion and maintain mechanical strength over time.

### Size and Load Considerations

Screws should be selected based on the load capacity of the cable tray and the expected cable weight . The diameter and length must be sufficient to securely fasten the tray to supports or walls without compromising the tray's structural integ...
