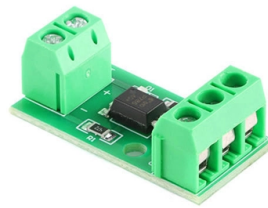


Requirements for carrying a power distribution box outdoors



Overview

Low voltage distribution box outdoor use requires IP65 or NEMA 4X ratings, corrosion-resistant materials, and proper sealing for lasting weather protection. An outdoor electrical distribution box serves as the critical junction point where incoming power lines are split into multiple branch circuits for outdoor installations, parking lots, building exteriors, and industrial facilities. Unlike standard junction boxes, these distribution systems must. You'll learn what they are, why they're required, the difference between junction boxes and distribution boxes, types available (pull boxes vs splice boxes), NEC 314 sizing requirements, and how to choose the right one for your project.
