

Routine maintenance of fiber optic lines

Routine maintenance of fiber optic lines focuses on preventive inspections, cleaning, environmental monitoring, and stress-free installation to ensure long-term network reliability.

Preventive Maintenance Principles

Fiber optic networks are designed to be highly reliable and generally do not require frequent physical intervention unless damage occurs, such as accidental cuts or environmental stress (). Preventive maintenance emphasizes designing and installing the network correctly: burying cables deep enough to avoid accidental dig-ups, using conduits for exposed runs, supporting vertical cables, and ensuring proper bend radius and tension during installation ().

Inspection and Cleaning

Regular inspections are essential to prevent signal degradation:

- Visual inspections: Check cable routes, cabinets, splice closures, and patch panels for physical damage or stress ().
- Connector cleaning: Always clean connector end-faces before mating, using proper fiber cleaning tools. Inspect with a microscope and repeat cleaning if necessary ().
- Patch cord checks: Ensure no abnormal bends or stress on patch cords, and verify that connections are secure ().
