- **Enclosure Selection:** Choose enclosures based on environment and protection needs. Steel enclosures are durable and suitable for industrial use, while plastic enclosures are lightweight and corrosion-resistant, ideal for residential or light commercial applications ().
- **IP/NEMA Ratings:** Ensure the box has an appropriate IP or NEMA rating. Higher ratings provide better protection against dust and water, especially for outdoor or industrial installations ().
