

SC fiber optic patch cord connection

To connect an SC-type fiber optic patch cord, align the connector key with the adapter slot and insert it firmly until it clicks, ensuring the fiber ends remain clean and undamaged.

Step-by-Step Connection Guide

1. Identify the SC Connector and Port SC connectors are square-shaped with a push-pull design, commonly used in FTTH, CATV, and data networks. Check whether your patch cord is simplex (single fiber) or duplex (two fibers), as duplex cords have two connectors joined by a clip . 2. Inspect and Clean the Connector Before connecting, always inspect the ferrule (the fiber tip) for dust or debris. Use a fiber optic cleaning tool or lint-free wipe with isopropyl alcohol to clean the end face. Dirty connectors can cause signal loss or damage . 3. Align the Connector SC connectors have a key on the top. Align this key with the keyway in the SC adapter or transceiver port. Proper alignment ensures the fiber cores meet correctly, minimizing insertion loss . 4. Insert the Connector Push the SC connector straight into the adapter or port until you feel a firm click. The push-pull design locks the connector in place. Avoid twisting or forcing the connector, as this can damage the fiber . 5. Verify the Connection Once connected, check the link using a fiber tester or network device to ensure proper signal transmission. For duplex connections, ensure the Tx (transmit) and Rx (receive) fibers are correctly oriented . 6. Handling Tips

- Avoid bending the patch cord sharply; maintain the minimum bend radius.
- Do not touch the ferrule end face.
- Keep unused connectors capped to prevent contamination....
