A small network cabinet typically supports 24 inbound cables via a 24-port patch panel, occupying just 1U of rack space while allowing room for future expansion.

Cabinet and Patch Panel Overview

For small LAN deployments, a 24-port patch panel is standard, providing an ideal balance between capacity and space efficiency. This setup comfortably supports 20–40 endpoints, making it suitable for home offices, small businesses, or compact data centers . The patch panel occupies 1U of rack space, which fits easily into 6U, 9U, or 12U wall-mounted cabinets or larger 42U racks .

Cable Management Considerations

- Inbound cables from workstations or wall outlets are terminated at the patch panel, which acts as the boundary between the permanent link and the equipment cord .
- Cabinets often include vertical or horizontal cable managers to route cables neatly, prevent tangling, and maintain airflow .
- For small cabinets, the Net-Access™ inset frame design provides space for efficient cable routing and access, reducing operational costs and improving airflow .
