Small busbar terminals typically support 8–16 mm² conductors, 50–80 A current, and are designed for modular, safe, and compact panel integration.

Conductor Size and Material: Small busbar terminals generally accommodate copper or aluminum conductors ranging from 0.75 mm² to 25 mm² (18–4 AWG), depending on the terminal design and current rating. Copper is preferred for higher conductivity and lower voltage drop, while aluminum may be used for cost or weight considerations . **Current Rating:** Standard small busbar terminals are rated for 50–80 A, suitable for single-phase to four-phase systems. The rating depends on the busbar cross-section, terminal design, and installation conditions . **Busbar Spacing and Dimensions:** Common bar center distances are 40 mm, 60 mm, 100 mm, and 185 mm, with small terminals often used in 40–60 mm spacing for compact panels. Busbar cross-sections for small terminals typically range from 8–16 mm² . **Mounting and Connection:** Terminals are designed for tool-free or screw-tightened connections. Installation involves sliding the MCB or device onto the busbar, ensuring proper alignment, and tightening terminal screws to the recommended torque (e.g., max 2 N·m / 17.5 in·lb for small conductors) to ensure reliable electrical contact . **Insulation and Safety:** Many small busbar terminals feature overmolded insulation, finger-safe covers, and all-round contact hazard protection to prevent accidental contact and enhance durability . Optional overmolding can improve insulation thickness and sealing for harsh environments. **Short-Circuit and Thermal Considerations:** The short-circuit strength depends on busbar cross-section, terminal design, and spacing. Terminals are rated to handle short-circuit currents typical for their application, and...
