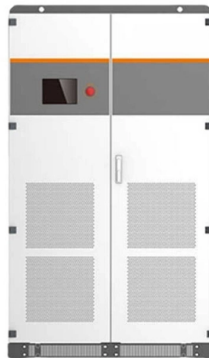

A large-pair optical fiber cable is a fiber-optic cable containing multiple pairs of optical fibers bundled together to support high-capacity data transmission over long distances.

Overview

A large-pair optical fiber cable is designed to carry many optical fibers in a single cable assembly, often organized in pairs or groups. Each fiber pair can transmit data independently, allowing the cable to handle high bandwidth and multiple simultaneous communication channels. These cables are commonly used in telecommunications, data centers, and long-haul network infrastructure where large volumes of data must be transmitted efficiently.

Structure

The cable typically consists of:

- Optical fibers: Thin strands of glass or plastic that carry light signals. Each fiber has a core for light transmission and a cladding layer to ensure total internal reflection, minimizing signal loss .
- Coatings and buffer layers: Each fiber is coated with protective layers, such as acrylate polymer or polyimide, to prevent physical damage and maintain signal integrity
