

Stacking Gigabit Optical Modules



Article Overview

Stacking Gigabit optical modules allows multiple switches to operate as a single logical unit, using SFP or SFP+ transceivers with appropriate cabling for distance and reliability.

Overview of Switch Stacking

Switch stacking combines multiple switches into a single logical device, where one switch acts as the master and others as backups. This setup improves network reliability, simplifies management, and allows high-volume data forwarding. If the master switch fails, a new master is automatically selected to maintain uninterrupted service .

Types of Optical Connections for Stacking

- Direct Attach Copper (DAC)
- Fixed-length copper cable with modules at both ends.
- Low-cost, low-power solution for short distances (typically under 7 meters in a rack).
- Susceptible to electromagnetic interference, but sufficient for short-range stacking .
- Active Optical Cable (AOC)
- Fixed-length optical cable with integrated modules.
- Provides photoelectric conversion for longer distances (7-30 meters).
- Slightly lower cost than using two separate optical modules with a fiber jumper.
- Entire cable must be replaced if one module fails
