Key Printing Requirements

1. Hazard and Safety Notices Distribution boxes must include danger or warning plates to alert users to electrical hazards. For example, IS 2551-1982 specifies the use of danger notice plates for electrical enclosures, ensuring visibility and legibility under outdoor conditions . These markings should be resistant to weather and UV exposure for outdoor installations. 2. Material Identification and Recycling Information Boxes should indicate the material composition of the enclosure, such as plastics, metals, or composites, using standardized symbols or codes. For instance, Xerox packaging standards require suppliers to mark packaging with material identification numbers or resin codes to support recycling and regulatory compliance . This ensures traceability and adherence to environmental regulations. 3. Compliance and Certification Labels Distribution boxes must display certification marks such as ATEX, BASEEFA, or IEC conformity labels, depending on the region and application. GB distribution boxes, for example, are ATEX-certified and BASEEFA-approved, with markings indicating compliance with EC directives and explosion protection standards . IEC and IS standards may also require printed information about voltage ratings, IP protection class, and insulation coordination . 4.
