Construction site secondary distribution boxes are modular, weatherproof units designed to safely distribute low-voltage power to multiple circuits, typically compliant with IEC 61439 and IP65 standards.

Key Features

Voltage and Phases: Secondary distribution boxes operate at low voltage levels suitable for construction site equipment, typically 230/400V AC, and can support single-phase or three-phase connections depending on site requirements . **Safety and Protection:** Standard boxes are equipped with ELCBs (Earth Leakage Circuit Breakers), RCCBs (Residual Current Circuit Breakers), and RCBOs (Residual Current Breakers with Overcurrent) to prevent electrical hazards such as short circuits, overloads, and leakage currents . Double earthing is often implemented for enhanced safety. **Enclosure and Durability:** Boxes are usually IP65-rated, providing protection against dust, water, and harsh outdoor conditions. Materials include robust sheet steel or thermoplastic housings, often with powder-coated finishes for corrosion resistance . Impact resistance is typically rated IK08 or higher. **Modularity and Expandability:** Many construction DBs feature modular, bolted designs allowing easy expansion or reconfiguration to accommodate additional circuits or equipment. Pre-wired or empty housings are available for flexible installation . **Standards Compliance:** Leading manufacturers design these boxes in accordance with IEC 61439 for low-voltage switchgear and controlgear assemblies, and IEC 60364 for electrical installations, ensuring safety and reliability . **Installation Considerations:** Boxes can...
