

Standard weight of relay protection cabinet



Article Overview

The standard weight of a typical indoor relay protection cabinet ranges from approximately 150 kg to 400 kg, depending on size, material, and installed equipment.

Cabinet Construction and Materials

Relay protection cabinets are usually floor-mounted, rigid, and self-supporting, constructed from steel or aluminum with powder-coated finishes for corrosion resistance . They house 19" or 23" modular racks, protection relays, auxiliary relays, meters, wiring, and cable management systems . The cabinet frame, doors, side panels, and internal mounting rails contribute significantly to the overall weight.

Typical Dimensions and Weight Estimates

- Standard sizes: 2300 mm (height) × 800 mm (width) × 600 mm (depth) for 48RU cabinets .
- Smaller cabinets: 42RU or 36RU, often around 200–250 kg empty.
- Larger cabinets: 48RU or fully loaded with relays and wiring, can reach 350–400 kg or more.
- Material impact: Steel cabinets are heavier than aluminum; a steel 48RU cabinet may weigh 250–300 kg empty, while aluminum versions may be 150–200 kg .
