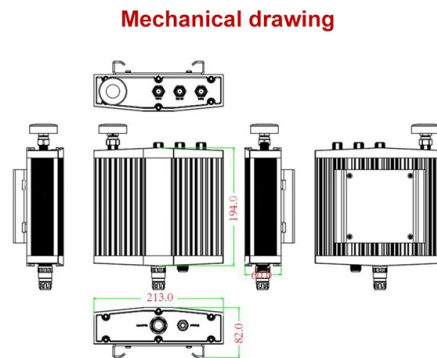


Standards for bending distribution boxes



Overview

28 defines the requirements for sizing pull boxes, junction boxes, and conduit bodies when conductors are 4 AWG or larger. Correct box dimensions are essential to protect conductors during installation and prevent excessive bending stress. A conduit body is a removable-cover section of a conduit system that provides access at junctions or termination points. Article 314 applies to: These.
