Adjustable brackets or telescopic support arms are recommended to accommodate tray extension and contraction. 2. Load Capacity and Material Selection: Cable trays must support the weight of cables, tubing, and instrumentation without sagging. Materials such as galvanized steel, stainless steel, aluminum, or fiberglass composites are commonly used, depending on environmental conditions and load requirements . Ensure that the tray and support system are rated for the maximum expected load, including dynamic forces during installation or maintenance. 3. Compliance with Standards: Installation should follow recognized standards such as DIN EN 61537 or BS EN 61537, which define requirements for cable support systems, including mechanical strength, fire resistance, and environmental durability . Using components from the same manufacturer ensures compatibility and tested performance. 4. Fittings and Accessories: Telescopic trays often require specialized fittings such as straight connectors, angle connectors, reducers, and adjustable supports to maintain alignment and stability during extension .
