Polar Connect is a Swedish-led initiative to establish a secure, high-capacity fiber-optic connection between Northern Europe and Asia via the Arctic Ocean.

Overview of Polar Connect

Polar Connect is a Northern European project aimed at creating a resilient and ultra-high-capacity submarine fiber-optic link between Europe and East Asia, following the shortest route through the central Arctic Ocean . The initiative is led by SUNET (Sweden), the Swedish Polar Research Secretariat, and NORDUnet, a collaboration of Nordic National Research and Education Networks . The project is designed to support 12 to 24 fiber pairs, enabling extremely high data transmission capacity while bypassing geopolitically sensitive areas like the Red Sea, where most current Europe-Asia connections are routed .

Project Phases and Technical Details

- Polar Connect Step 1: Focuses on mapping the optimal Arctic route and establishing the initial infrastructure, including landfall connections in Sweden and Norway .
- Polar Connect Step 2: Plans to extend the network to North America and East Asia, creating a global resilient submarine cable system .
- North Pole Fiber Project: Serves as the preparatory phase, establishing the groundwork for the Arctic fiber link and enabling SMART (Science Monitoring And Reliable Telecommunications) technology to collect environmental and climate data along the cable route . The Arctic route offers lower latency due to its shorter distance compared to traditional routes and provides digital sovereignty and netwo...
