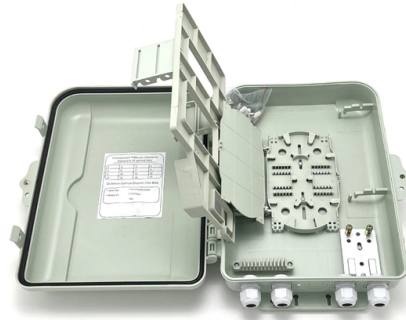


Switch Aggregation Uplink

An aggregation uplink switch consolidates traffic from multiple access switches and forwards it to core switches or routers, providing high-bandwidth, redundant, and scalable network connectivity.

Overview

An aggregation switch serves as an intermediary between access layer switches and core network devices, consolidating traffic from multiple edge devices such as access switches, wireless access points, or servers, and forwarding it efficiently to the core layer. It typically operates at Layer 2 or Layer 3 of the OSI model, depending on network requirements, and is designed to handle high throughput while reducing bottlenecks in enterprise, campus, or data center networks .

Uplink Functionality

The uplink ports on an aggregation switch connect to higher-level core switches or routers. These ports are often high-speed (10G, 25G, 100G) and may support fiber or multi-gigabit Ethernet to ensure sufficient bandwidth for aggregated traffic . Uplink ports can also be configured for link aggregation, combining multiple physical connections into a single logical link to increase bandwidth and provide redundancy .
