Copper vs Fiber for 200 Mbps

Traditional DSL lines over copper typically max out around 16 Mbps, while VDSL, which combines fiber to a street cabinet with copper for the last mile, can reach speeds up to 50 Mbps. With vectoring technology, VDSL can push speeds up to 250 Mbps, making it technically possible to achieve 200 Mbps without full fiber deployment to the home (FTTH) . However, performance depends heavily on the distance from the street cabinet and the quality of the copper lines.

Advantages of Fiber

Fiber optic cables transmit data using light, offering higher bandwidth, lower latency, and longer distances without signal degradation . Full fiber deployment (FTTH) can easily support 200 Mbps and beyond, with speeds up to 1 Gbps or more . Fiber is also more reliable and scalable, allowing future upgrades without replacing the physical cables .
