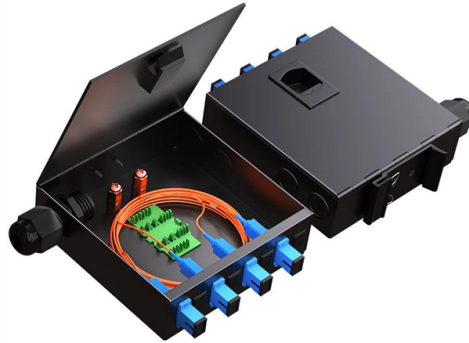


The optical cable cannot produce light

No light in an optical cable usually indicates a connection issue, physical damage, or incorrect device settings.

Check Connections

Start by inspecting both ends of the optical cable. Ensure the connectors are fully seated in the correct ports—output on the source device and input on the receiving device. Optical ports are directional, so connecting output to output or input to input will prevent light transmission. Remove any protective caps from the cable ends and check for dust or debris in the ports, which can block the light signal .

Inspect for Physical Damage

Optical cables are fragile. Look for bends, kinks, frays, or cuts along the cable. Even minor damage can disrupt the light signal. If the cable shows visible damage, it may need to be replaced .

Verify Device Settings

Ensure that the source device is set to optical or digital audio output. Some TVs, soundbars, or receivers require selecting the correct audio format (PCM, Dolby Digital, or DTS) for the optical output to function. Also, confirm that the receiving device is powered on and set to the correct input mode .
