

Using a regular switch for PoE power supply



Article Overview

A regular switch cannot directly supply PoE, but you can provide power to PoE devices by using a PoE injector or midspan device alongside the switch.

Key Points

A regular (non-PoE) switch only transmits data over Ethernet and does not provide electrical power to connected devices . This means that PoE-enabled devices, such as IP cameras, VoIP phones, or wireless access points, will not receive power if connected directly to a standard switch.

Options to Enable PoE with a Regular Switch

- PoE Injector (Midspan Device)
- A PoE injector is placed between the regular switch and the PoE device.
- It adds electrical power to the Ethernet cable while the switch continues to handle data transmission .
- This setup allows the device to receive both data and power without replacing the existing switch.
- PoE Splitter (for non-PoE devices)
- If a device does not natively support PoE, a PoE splitter can separate the power and data from a PoE-enabled cable, providing the correct voltage to the device.
