

Vertical Fixing of Grid Cable Tray

Key Considerations for Vertical Installation

Structural Support: Cable trays are designed to support weight in the horizontal orientation. When installed vertically, the tray's side rails must bear the load, which they are not typically designed for. This requires closer spacing of supports and may necessitate reinforced or specialized vertical tray systems to prevent sagging or failure . **Cable Securing:** In vertical trays, every cable must be secured to prevent sliding or piling. Standard cable ties may be insufficient, and over-tightening can damage insulation. Specialized vertical cable racks with hooks or rails are recommended, as they support cables without relying solely on ties . **Heat Dissipation and Ampacity:** Vertical stacking increases cable density, which can lead to higher operating temperatures. This requires de-rating of cable ampacity to account for reduced airflow and heat accumulation. Larger cable sizes may be needed to maintain the same load capacity . **Compliance and Safety:** Vertical installations may not be UL-listed or tested in the same configuration as horizontal trays. It is essential to consult the manufacturer and adhere to standards such as DIN EN 61537 for cable support systems, ensuring mechanical and environmental suitability . **Alternative Solutions:** For long vertical runs or high-density installations, consider vertical cable racks or conduit systems. These are designed to maintain cable position, allow future additions, and reduce labor-intensive securing compared to turning a horizontal tray on its side
