Types of Optical Cables

1. Single-Mode Fiber (SMF)

- Features a narrow core ($\sim 9 \mu\text{m}$) that allows only one light mode to propagate.
- Ideal for long-distance, high-speed transmission such as backbone networks and long-haul telecommunications.
- Offers low attenuation and high bandwidth, but is more delicate and expensive to manufacture . 2. Multimode Fiber (MMF)

- Has a wider core ($50\text{--}62.5 \mu\text{m}$) supporting multiple light modes.
- Suitable for shorter distances, such as within buildings, campuses, or data centers.
- Easier to install and less expensive than single-mode, but has higher attenuation and lower transmission speed . 3. Plastic Optical Fiber (POF)

- Made of plastic fibers, thicker and more robust than glass fibers.
- Cost-effective and durable, often used in consumer electronics or short-distance applications, but not ideal for long-distance data transmission . 4. Braided Optical Fiber (BOF)

- Composed of multiple braided glass fibers for enhanced strength and durability.
- Commonly used in industrial environments where mechanical stress is high . 5. Ar...
