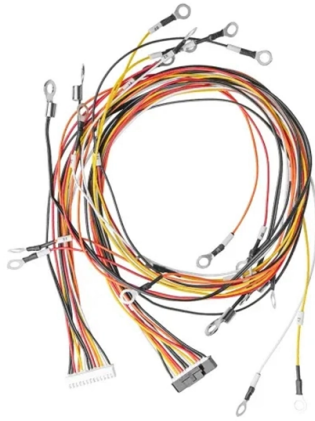


What are the specifications for electrical distribution boxes in residential buildings

Placement and Accessibility

- Distribution boxes should be readily accessible for operation, maintenance, and inspection .
- Recommended mounting height for residential units is 1 to 1.8 meters from the floor, with 1.3 meters suggested for elderly or handicapped residents
