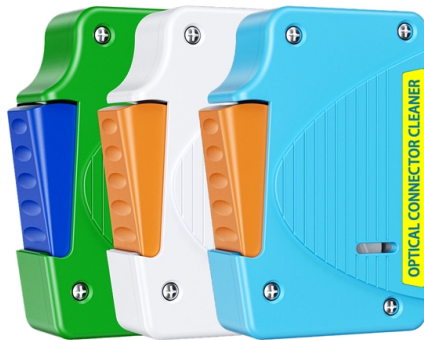


What does dual power supply mean for network security devices

Dual power supplies in network security devices provide redundancy, ensuring continuous operation even if one power source fails.

What Dual Power Supplies Mean

A network device with dual power supplies contains two independent power supply units (PSUs) capable of powering the device individually. This design ensures that if one PSU fails, the other immediately takes over without interrupting the device's operation, maintaining network uptime and reliability. This feature is especially important for critical infrastructure like firewalls, routers, and switches, where downtime can have significant operational and financial consequences.

Types of Redundancy

- Full Redundancy (1:1 or 1+1): Each device is connected to two power supplies, and both are active or ready to take over instantly. If one fails, the other continues to power the device seamlessly.
- Partial Redundancy (1:N): One extra power supply supports multiple devices. In this case, switching to the backup may take a short time, unlike the immediate transition in full redundancy.

- Combined Mode: Both PSUs share the load, increasing efficiency and potentially s...
