These patch cords are used to connect optical devices such as switches, transceivers, patch panels, and distribution boxes, enabling data transmission through optical networks. The FC connector is known for its screw-on mechanism, which provides a stable and vibration-resistant connection, making it suitable for environments where reliability is critical, such as telecom networks and laboratory equipment.

Structure

A typical FC patch cord consists of:

- Optical Fiber Core: Transmits light signals; can be single-mode (SM) or multimode (MM) depending on the application.
- Cladding: Surrounds the core to maintain light integrity.
- Buffer Coating: Protects the fiber from physical damage.
- Outer Jacket: Provides durability and environmental protection.
- FC Connectors: Each end has an FC connector with a ceramic ferrule that aligns the fiber precisely for low insertion loss and high return loss
