An elevated cable tray is a cable support system mounted above the floor or ground to route, organize, and protect electrical and communication cables.

Definition and Purpose

An elevated cable tray is a structural system designed to support insulated electrical cables above the floor, ceiling, or other surfaces, providing a clear pathway for power, control, and communication cables in industrial, commercial, or utility environments . Unlike conduit systems that fully enclose cables, elevated trays allow for easy access, maintenance, and future expansion . They help prevent cable sagging, overheating, and mechanical damage while keeping the installation organized and safe .

Structure and Design

Elevated cable trays are typically made from metallic materials such as steel, aluminum, or stainless steel, and may feature ladder, perforated, solid-bottom, or wire mesh designs . The choice of design depends on factors like cable type, weight, heat dissipation needs, and environmental conditions . Ladder trays, for example, have side rails connected by rungs, allowing ventilation and supporting heavy power cables, while perforated or solid trays provide continuous support for smaller or sensitive cables .
