

What is the installation height of the mesh cable tray

The minimum height requirement for cable trays exposed to physical damage is 2.5 meters (8 feet) above grade.

Key Height Requirements

- **Minimum Height:** According to OSHA regulations, cable trays should be installed at a minimum height of 2.5 meters (8 feet) above the ground, especially in areas where they may be exposed to physical damage from vehicular traffic or other hazards .
- **Vertical Spacing:** When installing multiple cable trays, the vertical spacing between them should be at least 150 millimeters (approximately 6 inches) to ensure proper airflow and maintenance access . This spacing helps prevent overheating and allows for easier inspection and cable management.
- **Horizontal Spacing:** If installing cable trays in parallel, maintain a horizontal distance of at least 0.6 meters (approximately 2 feet) between them to facilitate maintenance and reduce the risk of electromagnetic interference .

- **Compliance with Standards:** Ensure that the installation complies with relevant electrical codes and standards, such as the National Electrical Code (NEC) and NEMA standards, which provide guidelines for safe and effective cable tray installations .
