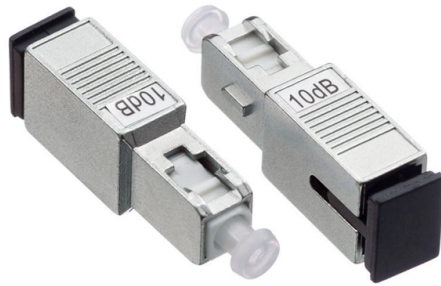


What kind of lines are connected to a fiber optic connector
