Fiberglass-Reinforced Plastic (FRP) trays are highly resistant to corrosion, chemicals, and extreme temperatures, making them ideal for marine environments, chemical plants, or areas with high humidity. FRP trays are non-conductive, which can provide additional electrical safety benefits. Plastic (PVC) trays are lightweight, corrosion-proof, and cost-effective, but they are less durable and cannot support heavy cable loads or withstand harsh mechanical stress. They are typically used in light-duty or indoor applications
